And so we do. Samaritan's Purse, an international Christian relief and evangelism organization, offers spiritual and physical aid to hurting people in the Name of Jesus. Since 1970, Samaritan's Purse has provided clean water, food, shelter, medical aid, and other basic necessities along with the Gospel message to people in desperate situations around the world.

Our Operation Christmas Child project is a practical way to share the hope of Jesus with children living in countries that have been ravaged by poverty, war, famine, disease, or natural disaster by sending them gift-filled shoeboxes.

Each year, Samaritan's Purse selects a few dedicated volunteers to personally deliver Operation Christmas Child boxes to boys and girls overseas. These trip participants experience—with all of their senses—how each unique shoebox gift impacts the life of a child, family, and community. They assist our international partners in equipping the local church with evangelism opportunities, and they return empowered to serve in their church and in the ministry of Operation Christmas Child.
